

IMPACT AND RETIRED MEMBERS

Since 1991, IMPACT has facilitated retired members of the Union to remain in membership. [See below for definition of a retired member]. As the range of services that we can provide to retired members is lesser than that for ordinary members, the rate of subscription payable is 50% that of ordinary members and subject to the same overall maximum ceiling. The current rate of subscription of retired members is 0.4% of pension.

Retired members will, unless otherwise decided by the Union's Central Executive Committee, remain as members of their original branch. Where there are sufficient numbers of retired members in a branch, a retired members' section may be set up, with a representative on the branch committee. [A sample 'constitution' for a retired members' section is available on request]. A Retired Members' Vocational Group can be established if there is sufficient demand.

Retired members are entitled to information and all IMPACT publications available to members generally. They are also entitled to access to relevant IMPACT membership benefit schemes. As they are no longer in employment, industrial relations representation is restricted to pension related matters.

A retired member of IMPACT is eligible to remain as a member provided;

- (i) they are aged 55 years or over, or if younger, have retired on health grounds;
- (ii) they were a member in benefit of IMPACT immediately preceding their retirement from service;
- (iii) they pay the appropriate membership subscription;
- (iv) have not re-entered employment where he/she would be eligible to be an ordinary member of IMPACT or any other trade union.

Payment of membership subscription by a retired member may be by deduction at source from pension [where the payer of the pension is agreeable] or by Standing Orders. [Forms available on request].
